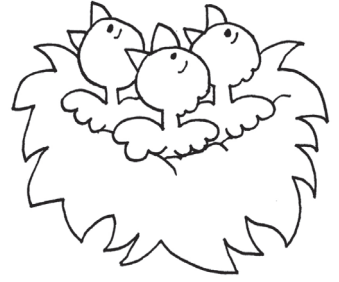
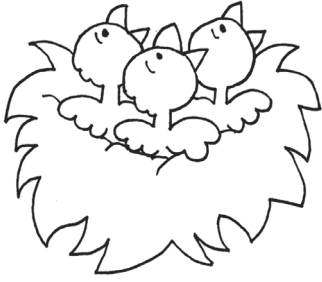

The Bard Street Book Store has been in its new space for over a year, and customers report that it is now much easier to browse the shelves and find exceptional buys. Inventory turns over much more quickly, and new book donations are sorted and displayed several times a week. Each section (hardcover & paperback fiction, poetry & drama, biography, business, travel, etc.) is clearly labeled and impeccably organized. Prices have not changed and remain the lowest in the South Bay. Most paperbacks and DVDs are a spectacular bargain at **50¢**, most hard covers **\$1**.
